



COVID19 Business Specific Health & Safety Form HAIR SALONS and BARBERSHOPS

NOTE: In order to self-certify compliance at www.mendocinocountybusiness.org, you must **read and implement** the County of Mendocino-specific guidelines for Hair Salons and Barbershops issued in the September 22, 2020 Public Health Order.

In order to fill out this form and create a health and safety plan for your business, refer to the [State of California Guidelines for Hair Salons and Barbershops](#) dated October 20, 2020, the [County of Mendocino Public Health Order dated September 22, 2020](#) and the [County of Mendocino Facial Coverings Order dated July 2, 2020](#). A health and safety plan is required to operate.

NOTE: Effective August 28, 2020, hair salons and barbershops may open indoor operations with modifications and follow the guidance: [hair salons and barbershop services provided outdoors](#)

1. Describe the type of signage you will have and locations. **Must wear a facial coverage and Don't enter if you have any illness symptoms will be posted at the front door.**
2. Describe the PPE you will provide to your employees and clients. **Hand sanitizer, and disposable masks will be provided at the entrance of the shop**
3. Describe your plans for training employees and contract workers on the use of PPE; disinfection; sanitation and other cleaning techniques. **No employees**
4. Describe your plans for protecting your employees' and clients' health. **I will be wearing a mask at all times. I had both of my covid vaccine shots recently. Prior booking an appointment client needs to answer covid safety questions. Sanitizing before and after each clients throughoutly.**

5. Describe how you will prevent crowds gathering at your facility. **Only one client at a time is allowed.**
6. Describe how you will enforce physical distancing at your facility. **I will request people to wait outside, if there is already a person in the hair studio.**
7. Describe your reservation system and state the gap between client appointments to allow for sanitation practices. **I have set up my book an hour and 15 min time slots on my booking calendar between each client to ensure enough time for cleaning, and sanitizing hair implements, brushes etc..but also door knobs, chair..**
8. Describe the payment methods you will use (contactless is preferred). **Cash or PayPal or check**
9. Describe the methods used to clean and disinfect shears, electric tools, clippers, etc.**all the electric tools will be sanitized with virucide, fungicide,bactericide disinfecting solutions or spray, after being washed with soap and water.**
10. Describe the methods used to clean and disinfect hoses, handles, chairs and other high-contact areas. **Bleach wipes and/or alcohol based spray cleaner**
11. Describe the methods for cleaning and disinfecting towels, smocks, capes and other reusable items. **All towels and capes and other reusable items will be used only once and will be washed.**
12. Describe the occupancy limitations for the facility; workers and clients. **One client at a time.**
13. Describe how you will reconfigure seating and walking areas to maintain six feet of physical distancing in your facility. **There will be only the client and I in the space at all times.**
14. If applicable, describe how you will indicate separate entry and exits to/from your facility.
